

Once a building permit is issued to a residential builder or remodeler, or the holder of a certificate of responsibility (commercial contractors) by a municipal or county building official, or any other authority charged with the duty of issuing local building permits, such licensed residential builder or residential remodeler or holder of a certificate of responsibility shall exhibit a sign at the permitted job site which shall include, prominently displayed in lettering at least two (2) inches high and twelve (12) inches wide, the license or certificate of responsibility number of the residential builder or residential remodeler or holder of a certificate of responsibility (commercial contractors) and the State issuing it.
