## APPLICATON FOR BEER PERMIT

To the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of Waynesboro, Mississippi:

Application is hereby made for a permit to engage in the business of retailing beer in the City of Waynesboro, Mississippi under the provisions of Chapter 3, Section 67-3-5 et seq, Laws of the State of Mississippi of 1972 as amended.

**(READ CAREFULLY)**

I, or we, the applicant, or applicants, or duly authorized agent, or agents of the applicant, or applicants, for whom the permit is applied do hereby state upon oath that I, or we, are familiar with the beer ordinances of the City of Waynesboro, Mississippi, and agree to abide by said ordinances and that the following facts are true, and I, or we, do hereby obligate the recipient of this permit under full penalty of the law of the following terms and conditions:

1. That the person or persons names in this application for permit to engage in the business of retail dealer in beer in Waynesboro, Mississippi, are 21 years of age, and of good moral character, and citizens of the United States of America and the State of Mississippi.
2. That the person or persons names in this application for permit to engage in the business of retail dealer in beer in Waynesboro, Mississippi, have not been convicted of a felony, or of pandering, or of keeping or maintaining a house of prostitution, or have not been convicted within five years of the date of this application of any violation of the laws of this City or the United States of America relating to alcoholic liquor.
3. That neither the individual nor any partner nor officer of the corporation named in this application for permit to engage in the business of retail in beer in Waynesboro, Mississippi, has been revoked within five years next preceding this application, any license or permit issued to him/her under the laws of this state, or any other state, to sell alcoholic liquor of any kind.
4. That the person or persons named in this application for permit to engage in the business of retail dealer of beer in Waynesboro, Mississippi are the owner of the premises for which the permit is sought, or the holder of a valid lease on the premises described.
5. That all of the representatives contained in the forgoing four paragraphs apply individually and collectively to all officers and directors of any corporation, and to any stock holder owning more than 5% of the stock of such corporation, making application of this permit to engage in the business of retail dealer in beer in Waynesboro, Mississippi.
6. The applicant will not:
  - (1) To sell, give or dispose, or permit to be consumed on any licensed premises any beer between the hours of midnight and 7:00 A.M. on weekdays, and between midnight on Saturday to 7:00 A.M. Monday morning on weekends, 12:00 A.M. on Christmas Day til 7:00 A.M. the following day, or Election Days for Primary, Preferential, or General Elections for the election of public officials during the hours that the polls are open.
  - (2) To sell, give, or furnish any beer to any visibly intoxicated person, or to any insane person, or to any habitual drunkard, or to any person under the age of Twenty One (21), or to allow any of such persons to consume beer on the licensed premises except as provided for by Section 67-3-54 Mississippi Code 1972 as amended.
  - (3) To permit any lewd, immoral, or improper entertainment, conduct or practices on the licensed premises.
  - (4) To permit any breaches of the peace, or boisterous and disorderly conduct upon the licensed premises.
  - (5) To permit the use of loud musical instruments if same may disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood where such business is located.
  - (6) To permit minors and known criminals, and prostitutes to frequent the licensed premises.
  - (7) To permit or suffer gambling and operations of games of chance upon the licensed premises.
  - (8) To receive, possess, sell, or permit any person to consume on the licensed premises any beverage of any kind or character containing more than four (4%) per centum alcohol by weight.

- (9) To fail to maintain sanitary and satisfactory separate rest rooms and sanitary water closets for men and women patrons.
- (10) To sell, give, dispense, permit to be sold, given, or dispensed, any beer at any business, places or establishment within a radius of 250 feet of any school house or school grounds upon which said school house is located, Church, Funeral Home, Kindergarten, or any other areas as might prove harmful to general welfare, health and morals of the community.
- (11) To work or employ any person under the age of Twenty One (21) years in said place, business, or establishment except as provided by Section 67-3-54, Mississippi Code 1972, annotated as amended.
