MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE PLACING OF REGULAR OR PORTABLE SIGNS SO AS NOT TO CREATE A TRAFFIC HAZARD

WHEREAS, Section 21-13-1 of the Mississippi Code
Annotated of 1972, as amended, vests the governing
authorities of Mississippi municipalities with the power to
pass ordinances; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Waynesboro that certain signs, either portable or regular, are being placed in positions that block the view of persons approaching an intersection or that the blinking electric signs tend to blend with the stop signs or stop lights and are creating a traffic hazard, and that some regulations should be ordained to eliminate these hazards.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Waynesboro as follows:

No advertising signs either regular or portable, either electric or non-electric, should be placed so as to block the view of persons approaching a red light or intersection or in any manner that would create a traffic hazard.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is further ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen that all such signs should be moved and adjusted so as not to block the view of the intersections, stop signs, stop lights, and the Chief of Police be granted the authority to make the proper determination as to the proper location of said signs. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by fine of not more than \$500.00 or six months in jail, or both.

The City Clerk be authorized to publish this City
Ordinance in the paper of general circulation in Wayne County,
Mississippi.

This ordinance shall be in effect from and after the effective date of its passage.
